INFORMATION FROM GERMANTOWN COMMUNITY THEATRE

Germantown Community Theatre, a 501(c)(3) organization, embarked on its 38th season in fall, 2009. GCT was founded in 1972, first performing in the Germantown Community Center before moving to the old chapel of the Presbyterian Church (formerly St. George’s Church) in 1973. In 1981, a group of dedicated volunteers rehabilitated the quaint turn-of-the century schoolhouse at 3037 Forest Hill-Irene Road into the intimate theatre that can be found there today - increasing its audience capacity by 50%. In 1990, the 112 seat theatre was refurbished and a rehearsal hall was added to the property - easing the growing pains of the theatre.

In addition to our 7-show season, we host educational and outreach programs for children and seniors. Here at GCT, we know exposure to theatre helps in the development of creativity and imagination.

If they do work for you make sure their licenses and insurance are current. If they have an accident on your property and are not insured they could sue you. Do not pay for the work up front. Get an estimate in writing. Ask your neighbor who they use or check with our contractor list on line at www.poplarestates.net.
