### **Poplar Estates Real Estate Update**

With rising inflation, increased borrowing costs and high material prices the general market saw far fewer buyers and sellers across the board as the nation wearily eyed a potential recession. Even Germantown homes were not immune to the sluggish economic environment as November home sales were down 15% year over year in terms of units. Although demand significantly softened throughout 2023, the value of Germantown real estate continued to show through with the average sale price increasing 19%. Happily Poplar Estates alone got 17 new residents and neighbors! Germantown currently has a whopping 108 properties for sale ranging from

\$350,000 to just shy of six million! With interest rates slowly ticking down and a steady stream of families leaving the city of Memphis, I think it's safe to say that in 2024 we'll have even more community members and friends to welcome to our great little city.
